RISE: a campaign serving a concrete, ambitious, and measurable project





The AHADI Impact Program transforms the leadership of women with disabilities into a lasting driver of inclusive growth, social justice, and systemic change.

Through AHADI Leadership and AHADI
Community, it deploys a measurable architecture
of action, aligned with both the United Nations
Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs 5, 8, 10
and 17) and the UN Convention on the Rights of
Persons with Disabilities (CRPD) — particularly
its articles on equality, participation, employment, and
political representation.

A two-pillar program architecture

AHADI LEADERSHIP

Unleashing 1,000 women with disabilities as leaders by 2030.



A structured program providing annual support to 200 established women with disabilities — entrepreneurs, executives, elected officials, and activists.

Phase 1 — Intensive Training (4 months)

An immersive cycle built around seven core pillars:

- Strengthening self-confidence and personal development
- Developing economic empowerment
- Enhancing visible leadership
 & personal branding
- Mastering media communication and influence
- Structuring political advocacy and impact strategy
- Encouraging civic engagement
 & access to public office
- Building and leading community networks



Participants apply their learning through:

- Political dialogue with public authorities to advance implementation of the four key
 CRPD articles monitored by the AHADI 2030
 Observatory:
- Elimination of intersectional discrimination against women and girls with disabilities
- Access to decent work
- Universal accessibility
- Effective political participation
- Media visibility initiatives to reshape social perceptions of disability
- Creation of local micro-communities led by participants to cascade leadership and expand the movement's reach

Regional, continental, and transcontinental gatherings further strengthen the network's momentum and foster the emergence of a global, inclusive leadership movement.







Inspiring, connecting, and multiplying impact

This second pillar extends the momentum of AHADI Leadership by creating a local ripple effect: alumni become mentors, trainers, and ambassadors of collective change.

Starting in 2027, **1,000 young women with** disabilities will be supported each year.

Activation Pathway (3 months)

- Personal development
- Peer inspiration and motivational workshops
- Experience-sharing and collective stimulation

Project Pathway (up to 6 months)

- Tailored guidance toward employment, entrepreneurship, or civic engagement
- Connections with incubators, political networks, and professional coaches





IMPACT, OBJECTIVES & VISION

Structural Transformation Objectives

Strengthen economic empowerment

→ Access to quality employment, inclusive entrepreneurship, and financial independence.

Stimulate socio-political leadership

→ Access to leadership roles, mandates, and decision-making positions.

Transform social perceptions of disability

→ Generate positive, powerful narratives led by the women themselves.

Build peer-support communities

→ Break isolation, foster sisterhood, and enable knowledge sharing.

Influence public policy

→ Structured advocacy, institutional dialogue, and collective mobilization.




Impact Measurement & Sustainability

The program is supported by a **Social Impact Contract** (SIC) ensuring full transparency of results and rigorous evaluation of social performance across three dimensions:

- Economic empowerment of participants
- Visible and influential leadership
- Evolution of social and political representations

Clear indicators — employment rate, income progression, mandates obtained, media coverage — ensure robust monitoring and traceable impact.
