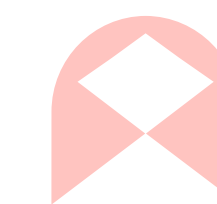

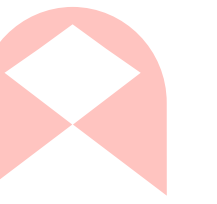
This program primarily targets disabled women in executive positions, business leaders, and elected officials. Each year, these women will be carefully selected and receive support to develop and strengthen their leadership. As a result, they will play a leading role in embodying and promoting AHADI Foundation's advocacy to public authorities and the media.

Through peer emulation and inclusive support pathways we offer, all disabled women within our communities will have the opportunity to develop their potential and empowerment, without exclusion, based on their individual interests and aspirations.

INAUGURAL LAUNCH OF THE «EMPOWERMENT & LEADERSHIP» PROGRAM

Targeting a hundred carefully selected disabled women in Europe and Africa, with an emphasis on leadership criteria such as entrepreneurship, political engagement, and leadership in business.

This pilot program includes:

- Co-creation, development, and testing of tools in close collaboration with participants.
- Adaptation and continuous optimization of tools based on feedback and identified needs.
- In-depth reflection on the framework and measurement tools for the program's impact.
- Establishment of strategic partnerships with companies, entrepreneurial incubators, public institutions, NGOs and cultural venues.

- Development and animation of a dynamic network of partners committed to empowering disabled women.

- Rigorous evaluation of the impact of the pilot program to identify successes and improvement opportunities.

- Final selection of candidates for the first cohort of the program, based on merit and leadership potential.

This pilot program marks a crucial step in the development of our initiative and will enable us to draw the necessary lessons to shape an innovative and effective leadership program for disabled women.
